Course Overview:

This lecture is designed to address critical problems encountered when performing root canal therapy using modern techniques to solve them. Using state of the art reciprocating and rotary instruments and techniques should allow the clinician to deal with diverse intracanal obstructions and curvatures in order to clean and shape the root canal efficiently to the root canal terminus.

Learning Objectives:

- Understand the use of reciprocation and rotary instruments, with their advantages and disadvantages.
- Learn how to efficiently determine and maintain a correct working length.

He serves on the Scientific Advisory Board for the Journal of Endodontics and the International Endodontic Journal. Dr. Vera has delivered over 500 lectures in 38 countries, including at meetings of the European Society of Endodontics and the American Association of Endodontists. He has published 87 endodontic articles and contributed to three books: "Irrigation in Endodontics" (2015), "Atlas of Endodontic Surgery" (2017), and "Endodoncia" (2011). He maintained a private practice limited to endodontics from 1993 to 2020.
